Fishing and Boating Checklist of Suggestions

- Hats, bandannas, and other such solar protection
- Shoes with good traction (with light colored rubber soles)
- Sunscreen, lip balm and other solar protection
- Sunglasses (polarized lenses reduce glare and help to see fish underwater)
- Food and snacks
- Lots of liquids (alcohol is acceptable, cozies suggested for glass beer bottles)
- A small cooler to bring home your catch (we can provide ice)
- Bug repellent (just in case, for when the wind is out of the west)
- Towels
- Long sleeve shirt or light jacket, an extra set of clothing, if desired
- Lightweight rain gear (for rain showers or just a cool breeze)
- Reading material, toys for children
- Camera, video equipment, extra film, memory and batteries
- Seasickness medicine (Over-the-counter medications, seem to be effective. A popular trick is to take a dose prior to bedtime the night before, followed by an additional dose before departure (effectiveness is greatly reduced if you wait until symptoms appear). Follow the instructions on the label and as with *any* medication, please consult a physician first! Other seasickness remedies include sipping ginger ale, watching the horizon, staying out in the fresh air, and pressure bands worn on the wrists.)

What Not to bring:
